SUBJECT: Cancellation of Administrative Support Services Competition

As you may be aware, legislation that became effective on May 25, 2007, (P.L. 110-28) resulted in elimination of more than 20 percent of the DOL positions covered by the Administrative Support Services Competition.

This is to advise you that it is the decision of the Department of Labor to cancel the Administrative Support Services Competition in its entirety, effective immediately. As such, the services you perform will not be transitioned to a private sector company. The Department has no immediate plans to re-run this competition.

In view of the foregoing developments, effective this date, the March 28, 2006, letter provided to you no longer applies and is hereby withdrawn, including your eligibility for priority consideration. Likewise, effective this date, the May 7, 2007, letter provided to you no longer applies and is hereby withdrawn, including your eligibility for special selection priority.

Voluntary Early Retirement Authority remains available through September 30, 2007, for DOL employees who are eligible. The Department will not offer Voluntary Separation Incentive Payments for positions included in the now cancelled Administrative Support Services Competition.
